As we slowly start to resume our daily lives after a year and a half of covid concerns and restrictions, we hope you and your families will enjoy the outdoors and reconnect with family and friends.

In 1999, the President's Message for the June 1999 newsletter written by former MPCA President Carmine Carro "Covenant" is a reminder of how we can continue to ensure our community continues the legacy of all our past Presidents and Board members who have worked through the years for the Marine Park Community.

The Random House Dictionary defines the word covenant as: 1. An agreement between two or more persons. 2. A promise made by a covenant. The items listed below are all important and their position on the list does not diminish their importance.

- 1. Be civil treat your neighbors as you would like to be treated.
- 2. Try to keep shared driveways clear.
- Clean up after your animals curb your dogs in the gutter not on the sidewalk. When walking your dog keep your dog on a leash.
- Try your best to put out garbage as late as you can the night before pick up. Keep garbage pails tightly covered. Marine Park Recycles – continue to recycle.
- 5. Be a Block Watcher act as the eyes and ears of the police. You can now contact our NCO's Neighborhood Coordinating Officers.

- 7. Keep the level of sound at a reasonable level. If you are having a party, consider your neighbors and lower the volume at a reasonable hour. This applies to cars also.
- 8. In the Fall, pick up and dispose of leaves properly.
- 9. Keep front and rear yards trimmed and maintained.
- 10. Find out when Community organizations meet. Attend if you can local Civic Associations, Community Board meetings, Parents Associations, etc..
- 11. Try to support Community events that are sponsored by Community Organizations.
- 12. Do not spread rumors find out the facts before repeating the story.

I look forward to seeing you at our next meeting outdoors in Marine Park adjacent to the Carmine Carro Community Center. This is the first Community meeting since our last one in February 2020 due to Covid restrictions. We hope to resume our regular monthly schedule in September. We will be installing our Board members at this meeting. A special thank you to all the Board members who continue to volunteer their time as well as former Board members.

Dear Neighbors,

Starting Tuesday, June 1, 2021 New York State is providing 3.5 billion in financial assistance to tenants, landlords and small-business owners who were impacted by COVID-19.

As apart of this years state budget both tenants and landlords can apply for the Emergency Rental Assistant Program (ERAP). ERAP will provide assistance with up to 12 months of past-due rent, three months of prospective rental assistance (benefits will be payed directly to landlords). Additionally, up to 12 months of utility arrears payments to eligible New Yorkers, regardless of immigration status.

The Small Business Recovery Grant was also passed as part of this year's state budget.



#### **Last Local Farm**

December 4, 1949 - Frank Albanese harvests his last Italian dandelion crop from remnants of a farm that once covered the site of the Sheepshead Bay-Nostrand houses shown in the background. The concrete points mark the site of the grandstand at the old Sheepshead Bay Racetrack, also known as the Coney Island Jockey Club, founded in 1880.

One of the Club's founders was Leonard Jerome, Winston Churchill's grandfather. His daughter, Lady Randolph Churchill, was born in Brooklyn. Jerome Avenue bears his name. He was also known as: "The King of Wall Street." Leonard is buried in Green-Wood Cemetery, Brooklyn.
